Let someone know if something is missing or broken Ask for help if you need it.	Follow the rules by taking turns, wearing sneakers, and listening to adults Ask for help if you need it. Line up when called Return equipment	Put things away when you are done. Clean up after yourself Ask for help Stay in your seats	Follow your classroom rules for asking for the bathroom Flush the toilet Wash your hands Throw paper towels in the garbage Turn off the water	Be sure your FMs are off Put your homework in your backpack Pick up my phone or Ipad from the principal's office.
