Cleary School for the Deaf 2023-2024 Student Device User Agreement

Cleary School for the Deaf is providing a computer device to all of our students.

The goals of the student device program include:

- Providing equity to all students through common technological device access.
- Facilitating students' confidence and proficiency in using technology as a tool to enhance learning.
- Promoting opportunities for students to demonstrate the ethics and etiquette necessary with technology use.
- Offering access to all information anytime, anywhere.
- Extending learning opportunities beyond the school day.

Students utilizing the device must follow all aspects of the Acceptable Use Agreement.

This agreement is made effective upon receipt of a student device betweenCleary School for the Deaf, the student receiving a device ("Student"), and his/her parent(s) or legal guardian ("Parent"). The Student and Parent(s), in consideration of being provided with a 1:1 device, including power adapter, case and software ("accessories") for use while a student at Cleary, hereby agree as follows:

1. Equipment

- 1.1. Ownership: Cleary retains sole right of possession of the 1:1 device and grants permission to the student to use the 1:1 device according to the guidelines set forth in this document and in conjunction with the Acceptable Use Policy.
- 1.2. Substitution of Equipment: In the event the 1:1 device is inoperable, Cleary has a limited number of spares for use while the 1:1 device is repaired or replaced. This agreement remains in effect for such a substitute. The student may NOT opt to keep a 1:1 device or to avoid using the 1:1 device due to loss or damage.
- 1.3. Configuration and Software: Efforts are made to keep all 1:1 device configuration the same. All systems include ample RAM, applications, and wireless network capability. The student may not install any software which violates the Cleary Acceptable Use Policy. Uninstalling any school provided or OS software or profiles from the 1:1 device is not permitted. Operating System and Application updates will be run from a central location. Failure to comply will result in disciplinary action.
- 1.4. Return of equipment: At the end of each school year students may be required to return the 1:1 device and all accessories to the school in good condition.
- 1.6. Technical Support and Repair: Cleary will provide technical support, maintenance, and repair during school hours. The devices may only be repaired through our school.

2. Legal and Ethical Use Policies

2.1. Monitoring: Cleary will monitor 1:1 device use using a variety of methods to ensure compliance with all applicable policies and this agreement. Any attempt to "jailbreak" the device or remove the Cleary profiles will result in disciplinary action.
